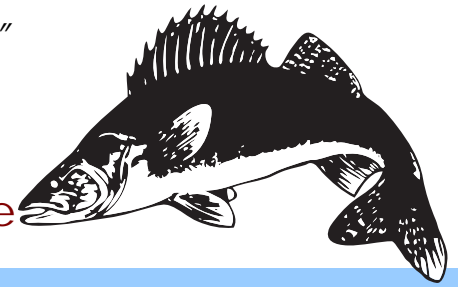

Hurray, I think that winter is finally over! There may be some additional snow, but it will quickly melt. It's almost April, so it must be time to fish for walleyes and crappies on the Fox Chain O' Lakes. We made our first trip out March 17th. Fishing was slow but, it will improve soon.

2008 Season Chain O' Lakes Walleyes

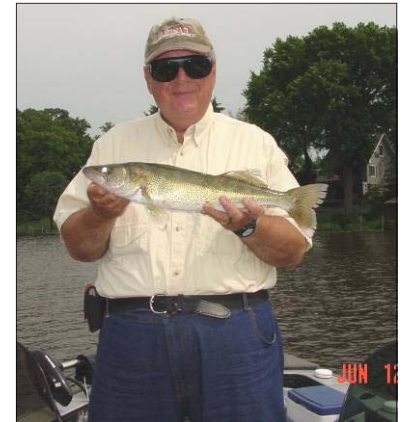
During the 2008 season our clients, friends and Capt. Walt caught many nice walleyes. These are some of the slot fish we caught. On the Fox Chain, a protected slot of 18-24" is in place for walleyes. All fish of that size must be immediately released. There are so many walleyes in the Chain right now, that the IDNR has increased the bag limit for 2009. This will allow anglers to keep 3 fish per day should you care to in the 14-18" range.
